

# Net Control Script

## 7:50pm, Pre-Net check-in:

*" This is (call sign). The Tuesday night Bay Area Amateur Radio Club Net will begin in approximately 10 mins. At this time I will take any pre-net check-ins."*

## 8pm:

*" This is (Name and Call sign) for the Bay Area Amateur Radio Club and I will be your Net Control for tonight. This is a Directed Net and as always any emergency or priority traffic will be handled immediately. Please address all communications to Net Control. You do not have to be a member of the Bay Area Amateur Radio Club to check-in, but you do need a Technician Class license or higher."*

*"This Net meets every Tuesday night at 8pm on the frequency of 147.360MHz with a - 600kHz offset and a PL tone of 131.8Hz. The purpose of this net is to promote amateur radio activities and fellowship in the local area and to exchange traffic, news and information with other Ham radio operators. Additional information about the Bay Area Amateur Radio Club can be found on our website at BAARC.net."*

*"Any station having emergency, priority or time-sensitive traffic, please call Net control now."*

(If no Emergency Traffic, state, **"Nothing heard"**)

*"Thank you everyone for joining tonight's net. When checking in please state your first name and call sign then please repeat it a second time."*

1). **Name and Callsign**

2). **Repeat**

*"At this time I'll take any In & Outs, Mobile, or Short-time Check-ins, please call now." **Once completed, repeat each caller's info and thank him or her for joining.***

*We will now take check-ins from all other stations. "Those who like to participate in tonight's Net please call now."*

**Once call-ins are completed repeat each caller's sign-in, location, and thank them for joining tonight's Net.**

*"Are there any other operators who would like to join the Tuesday night Bay City Amateur Radio Net at this time, please call now"*

*"For tonight's topic I'd like to discuss or talk about."*

*Topic(s): \_\_\_\_\_ (can be anything, be*

*creative.) 1: Lets start with (Call sign, name)"*

*2: After three check-ins or so (Break), "Is anyone else out there who would like to join our Tuesday night Bay City Amateur Radio Net at this time, please call now." .*

*3: "Okay we're at the bottom of the 1<sup>st</sup> round. Before we move on is there anyone else wishing to check-in? If so please call now."*

### ***Finish:***

*"Before we close the Net for this evening, do we have any additional stations that would like to check-in?"*

*(Break. Log and recognize any late check-ins)*

*"Anyone interested in attending a Bay Area Amateur Radio Club meeting is invited to do so. Our meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month at the Salvation Army building located at 401 10<sup>th</sup> St, Bay City. Meeting time is 7pm."*

*"At this time we will close the Tuesday evening Net. We had a total of \_\_\_\_ Check-in's, including myself. The Bay Area Amateur Radio club is a non-profit organization dedicated to the celebration, promotion, and advancement of the amateur radio hobby in and around Bay County. This Net meets each Tuesday at 8pm, on the frequency of 147.360MHz with a -600kHz offset and a PL tone of 131.8Hz."*

*I will now return this repeater back to general amateur use. For the Bay Area Amateur Radio Club, this is \_\_\_\_\_, (call sign) 73 and clear."*

**\*IF THERE ARE ANY EMERGENCY OR PRIORITY TRAFFIC CHECK INS MAKE SURE IT IS WRITTEN DOWN AND GOTTEN TO ITS PROPER DESTINATION.**

**\*2-3 ROUNDS FOR THE NET IS USUALLY SUFFICIENT.**

**\*IT IS A GOOD IDEA WHEN ASKING FOR CHECK INS TO ASK STATIONS TO SAY THEIR NAME AND CALLSIGN TWICE.**

**\*IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO MAKEOUT A STATION CLEARLY, BREAK AND ASK IF ANY OTHER STATIONS CAN HEAR MORE CLEARLY.**

**\*MAKE SURE TO KEEP A LOG OF ALL STATIONS CHECKING IN. EVEN IN AND OUTS**

\*IF YOU NEED TO LEAVE AS NET CONTROL ASK ANOTHER CLUB MEMBER THAT HAS CHECKED IN IF THEY CAN TAKE OVER THE NET.

\*THANK EVERYONE FOR CHECKING INTO THE NET.

\*REMEMBER THE NET IS TO ENDORSE CLUB PARTICIPATION AND OVER ALL AMATEUR RADIO USE.

\*HAVE FUN DOING NET. MAKE IT YOUR OWN.
